1928 From his farm in Sutton near Keighley, Richard Collett (1) begins transporting his and other farmer's milk to the dairy by horse and cart.

1933 Richard Collett (1) buys his first wagon and is employed by the MMB to collect milk, then in cans, from farms to be delivered to the dairies.

1962 Richard Collett (2) moves to a farm near Wainstalls, Halifax.

1964 The partnership between Richard Collett (1) and his son Richard Collett (2) is formed, creating the firm R. Collett & Son. Over the following years the milk transport fleet increases to 14 wagons and, in the early 70s, expands into general haulage and heavy transport.

1975 R. Collett & Sons (Transport) Ltd is formed. Over the coming years, the five sons of Richard (2) join the company to fill various roles (Richard (3), David, Lincoln, Mark and Michael).

1985 Due to growth, the company obtains a two-acre site in Keighley and now operates from twosites allowing for the expansion of the heavy transport side of the business.

1998 Both Depots are consolidated on a five-acre site at Victoria Terminal, Albert Road in Halifax, which enables the company to provide heavy lift and warehousing facilities. Business in the transportation of wind turbines increases, while the consultancy side of the business is launched.

2008 Another strategically placed ten-acre Depot is obtained at Goole, which becomes the birthplace of the Marine Department. The Projects Department also expands, including a mobile 110 Tonne Lift facility and extensive external storage.

2012 Our purpose built DVSA Testing Station is opened at our Hallfax Head Office allowing us to maintain our fleet to the highest of standards whilst also offering a testing facility for others within the Yorkshire area.

2013 Halifax becomes home to our Training4Transport Centre of Excellence Facility, an approved centre for JAUPT Driver CPC Periodic Training, FORS Safe Urban Driving and HABC Health & Safety Management.

2014 Our Grangemouth Depot is opened, providing a strategic portside location equipped with a 110 Tonne mobile Lifting gantry, whilst our Goole Depot becomes home to our newly acquired 550 Tonne capacity girder bridge.

2015 We introduce the Effer 205 Tonne/Metre crane and we welcome our SPMT power booster system.

2016 Collett Holdings Ltd is created with subsidiary companies for operational purposes, and the Collett Group join the Route To Space Alliance.

2017 We announce the launch of our new subsidiary company Collett (Ireland) Ltd. Our management systems across all three Depots become UKAS Accredited for ISO 9001:2015, ISO 14001:2015 and OHSAS 18001:2007 for the provision of transportation and Lifting services to all industry sectors.

2018 We become the first in our sector to be awarded the ISO.45001:2018 Accreditation for our management systems.





Additionally our Consulting Team can plan your movement with great precision, whilst our Marine Department can organise any shipping and chartering requirements for your cargo.

Our fleet of pilot cars comply with the Highways Agency's Self-Escorting of Abnormal Loads Code of Practice. Coupled with this, our qualified workforce allows us to skilfully and safely escort any abnormal load throughout the UK.

With meticulous planning in place ahead of each and every heavy transport project, our Team liaise with and arrange all police escort duties and requirements as demanded by the Police Authorities.

General Haulage

Our dedicated fleet of general haulage vehicles are engaged to carry out daily, weekly and monthly distribution contracts across the UK and Europe. Our fleet is available for spot hire and rapid response express delivery. We also operate a full load, part-load and groupage service throughout the UK with access to the pallet network.

This tracking ensures that we can follow the entire journey of your cargo from collection, through to transport, distribution and final delivery providing up to date progress information and an accurate time of arrival.

The expertise, experience and equipment across our general haulage operations allows us to provide a 24/7 complete rapid response transport solution.

Crane Vehicles & Lorry Loaders

Our heavy lift crane vehicle & lorry loader fleet features front and rear mounted cranes with lifting capacities ranging from 9 Tonne/Metre to 205 Tonne/Metre. These vehicles all meet BS7121 Part 4 regulations.

All our Crane Vehicle Operators are trained and certified, ensuring maximum safety when undertaking your lifting requirements.

Our ALLMI (Association of Lorry Loader Manufacturers and Importers) certified Drivers are highly experienced and skilled in self-loading and offloading freight and machinery. This allows us to safely and efficiently undertake lifting and positioning tasks without the need for hiring mobile cranes or fork trucks.

These cranes are mounted to artic tractor units and front & rear mounted to rigid vehicles which provide the ideal solution where space may be restricted.

For complex lifts, as defined in BS7121 Part 4 (Safe Use of Cranes) we provide qualified Appointed Persons (APs), Slinger Signallers and Crane Supervisors to plan and execute lifting operations. This service also incorporates the supply of RAMS (Risk Assessments and Method Statements), lift plans, calculations and other required documentation.

Working alongside our general haulage and heavy transport operations, the addition of our crane vehicles allows us to provide a heavy lift loading, offloading and flexible delivery solution. Furthermore, our Projects Team provide engineering calculations and planning for complex lifting solutions tailored specifically to each individual project.

The largest lorry loader in our fleet comes in the form of the Effer 2055. The largest of its kind in Europe, the Effer 2055 205 Tonne/Metre crane offers a powerful weight to ratio performance.

Warehousing & Heavy Lift Storage

Our indoor warehousing and outdoor storage facilities can accommodate long and short term requirements or can simply be used as a holding area for abnormal loads awaiting onward transport or shipment.

Our 5-acre Halifax Depot offers 40,000sq ft of warehousing space alongside container de-vanning, load securing and lashing, a purpose built docking area and a variety of forklift truck capacities up to 15 Tonne. Halifax also operates a calibrated weighbridge facility up to 100 Tonnes to conform with SOLAS containerisation regulations.

Our 10-acre Goole Depot offers 20,000sq ft of indoor warehousing, substantial outdoor storage, a 45 Tonne reach stacker and range of forklift trucks up to 28 Tonne capacity.

Our strategic 3-acre portside Grangemouth location provides a cost effective storage or transhipment solution and features a range of forklift trucks with lifting capacities of up to 15 Tonnes.

We also operate a range of flexible warehousing solutions, including block stacking and pallet racking.

Halifax features an internal modern heavy lift storage facility equipped with two overhead gantry cranes with lifting capacities of 30 and 32 Tonne. Our premises also offers the opportunity for test builds, complete with handling facilities and auxiliaries.

Our portside Goole Depot features a 110 Tonne straddle carrier, a 45 Tonne capacity container handler/top lift and up to 28 Tonne FLT equipment.

Our Scottish headquarters in Grangemouth features 110 Tonne and 45 Tonne straddle carriers and range of forklift trucks up to 15 Tonne.

All Depots are fully fenced, equipped with 24 hour CCTV coverage and have security guards in operation for maximum safety.

Where crane hire is not a suitable option we operate a hydraulic lifting gantry system, whilst our jacking & skidding systems and Self-Propelled Modular Transporters (SPMTs) provide the ideal solution for moving and positioning within restricted areas.

For projects which require consolidation facilities, our Depots at Halifax, Goole and Grangemouth all offer heavy lift storage facilities equipped with gantry cranes, straddle carriers and container handler/top lift equipment.



Industrial Services Jacking & Skidding

Utilising our specialist jacking & skidding equipment our Heavy Lift Team can ensure that no matter what the environment we can safely and securely undertake the transport and load positioning of machinery & industrial cargoes.

In restricted environments crane hire is not always a suitable option. Utilising our specialist hydraulic jacking & skidding systems, Collett Engineers have the ideal solution for these confined spaces, providing a lifting and load positioning service in areas where traditional transport arrangements may not be a suitable option.

We operate a multi-functional synchronous hydraulic heavy lift system capable of monitoring the position of the load between the four jacks to within a 1mm tolerance. This innovative hydraulic jacking & skidding equipment allows us to raise and slide industrial machinery, transformers and components up to 500 Tonnes in a controlled manner, indoors or outdoors. With the option to pull, push, lift and lower, we can load directly to trailer or relocate industrial machinery in confined spaces.


